COVID-19 Compliance – Face Mask Wearing in Lodges

1. The current Public Health (COVID-19 Temporary Movement and Gathering Restrictions) Order 2021 mandates the wearing of face masks in any indoor area of non-residential premises.
2. This part of the Order applies to all of New South Wales and is not limited to Greater Sydney. Accordingly, it will have application to Clubs.
3. A person is not required to wear the mask when they are within the confines of their own room. There is also an exception to the rule when the person is eating or drinking.
4. Accordingly, a person would be required to wear a face mask in any part of the Club but for their own room. This would include the common area. However, a person may remove the mask while they eat or drink in the common area. Once they finished eating or drinking they must put the mask back on.
5. From a practical point of view all persons on Club premises should put the face mask on when they exit their room to travel to and from the common area, they should keep their mask on while attending to any preparation of food or drinks in the common area and they should immediately put their face masks back on after they finish consuming any food or drink to return to their rooms or another part of the Lodge premises.
